Dear Mr. David F. Alderman:

I am writing to inform you of **Regulation on test item classification for Designated Test Laboratory** (RRA Announce 2013-50, October 15, 2013) which refers to test scope and items that designated test laboratories could test.

Designating Authority and Accreditation Bodies shall accredit and designate testing laboratories that are capable of performing conformity assessment by **Regulation on test item classification for Designated Test Laboratory**. So the CABs do not need to continuously update to their designation each time the technical regulations are updated.

And also, the following EMC test items do not require testing laboratories to be accredited to perform EMC testing ; KN 61000-4-2, KN 61000-4-3, KN 61000-4-4, KN 61000-4-5, KN 61000-4-6, KN 61000-4-8, KN 61000-4-9, KN 61000-4-11, KN 61000-2-2, KN 61000-2-4, KN 61000-3-2 / KN 61000-3-12, KN 61000-3-3/ KN 61000-3-11, KN 16-1-1, KN 16-1-2, KN 16-1-3, KN 16-1-4, KN 16-1-5, KN 16-2-1, KN 16-2-2, KN 16-2-3, KN 16-2-4 and KN 16-2-5.

Last but not least, I have attached **Regulation on test item classification for Designated Test Laboratory** in English and I am pleased to request to update to the scope of recognition for testing laboratories under the MRA in two years.
